

For the thirteenth time, the

## "ADAC Hockenheim Historic - the Jim-Clark-Revival"

a major international slot racing event will take place on the "Paragon". A total of seven different racing classes will be start on the weekend of May 9-11, 2025 at the Hockenheimring on a wooden track provided by the Hockenheim Racing Center. With the opening race on Wednesday, May 7, 2025, participants who arrive early will be offered their first racing experience during the week. The track will be available continuously from Friday to Sunday. The exact opening times can be found in a separate document (time planning), although the time schedule may still change based on the entries.

The following classes are available:

### 1.) Racecar Legends

At the Race Car Legends, formula vehicles based on models from Formula 1, Formula 2, Formula 3000 and Indycars will cause a sensation in a total of 2 different historical classes.

- 1.1) "Retro" class with vehicles built between 1969 and 2022 inclusive
- 1.2) "71-85" class with vehicles built between 1971 and 1985 inclusive

All classes are run according to the "Race Car Legends" regulations.

The "Retro" class is only offered as a sprint race.

In the "71-85" class you can take part in either the sprint race or the regularity race.

### 2.) Midgets 1300

This racing class includes all touring cars and GTs up to 1300 cc. The model vehicle must have been used in racing up to and including 1979. Open model vehicles must be converted into a closed model, i.e. with a hardtop or closed hood. For widened vehicles, a picture of the original from that time must be submitted.

The race management always decides on the admission of the vehicles to the race. A precise list of eligible model vehicles can be found on our homepage [www.renncenter-hockenheim.de](http://www.renncenter-hockenheim.de) , as well as the regulations. The race will be held in sprint mode.

### 3.) CanAm / Prototypes

This racing series is intended to commemorate a special era in motorsport. All open vehicles in the CanAm and Interserie classes as well as 2-litre sports cars built up to and including 1979 are permitted. The technical regulations are taken over completely from the German Slot Classic Series, Class 2, which can be read at [www.deutscheslotclassic.de](http://www.deutscheslotclassic.de). During the race, participants are offered the choice between sprint races and regularity tests (GLP).

### 4.) Historic Touring Cars up to 1981

This is a race for touring cars with at least 2+2 seats that were built up to and including 1981 and competed worldwide in Groups 1 to 4 or in the American TransAm or NASCAR series. The technical regulations correspond to the DSC, Class 1; for vehicles up to 1300 cc, the Midget regulations apply. Due to the large variety of vehicles, this race can also be held as a regularity race or a sprint race.

### 5.) Historic Times GP 2025 „60 Years Lotus 40“

At the Historic Times GP, vehicles from 1964 and 1965 will compete against each other in honor of “60 years of the Lotus 40”. Please only in their original condition from the years of manufacture 1964 and 1965, i.e. without extensions, spoilers or similar that were added in later years.

### 6.) Group 5

This racing series will be on the program for the first time in 2025. Vehicles from Group 5 will be driven, the regulations can be found on the homepage <https://renncenter-hockenheim.de/Hockenheim-Historic/Reglement/>

In order to have a precise overview of the number of starters, we ask you to pre-register digitally using the entry form on our homepage by April 19, 2025 at the latest.

We ask that you transfer the entry fee to our account.
